



COURT ORDER PROHIBITING WEAPONS IN SANPETE COUNTY COURTHOUSE

No firearm or other weapon of any kind is permitted in this courthouse, unless listed below and in the Local Security Plan. Persons entering these buildings are **subject to search** by law enforcement officers. Unlawfully possessed weapons will be **seized and forfeited**. Any person in violation of this order is subject to **arrest and punishment** for contempt.

The following officers may possess a firearm and ammunition in a courthouse, if the firearm is issued by or approved by the officer's appointing authority, if possession is required or permitted by the officer's appointing authority and the Local Security Plan, and upon a valid picture identification:

- Law enforcement officers
- Correctional officer
- Special function officer
- Federal officer
